We therefore continuously aim to reduce our carbon footprint and educate our customers and clients about how they can optimise their designs using Screedflo screeds and help minimise environmental impact.

Screedflo screed is made from anhydrite binder and locally sourced aggregate which when mixed with water creates a pumpable, liquid floor screed. Our screed is economically advantageous and a sustainable alternative to the labour intensive sand and cement screeds.

By incorporating the anhydrite binder Screedflo screed provides benefits, including:

Low-temperature underfloor heating
Low cost
Reduced waste

Our products include:

Standard liquid screed (C25/F4) used in most domestic and commercial applications with or without underfloor heating. We can lay this at a minimum of 30mm onto an existing slab, 35-40mm with insulation and 45mm+ with UFH.

Premium products – (C35/F6)

Screedflo Extra - used in garages, on timber floors and areas of high foot traffic, where a higher flexural strength is required

Screedflo Thermal - This can be laid at 40mm depth with UFH and conducts the heat 5 times more effectively than traditional screeds.

Screedflo Rapide - This screed has been tested and shown to be dry within 14 days of installation at a 50mm depth. It can be used in all the applications detailed above and improves drying times significantly.

Screedflo TS20 (C30/F5) - un-bonded onto a membrane, 20mm minimum depth to level off a concrete slab, or uneven floor.

- Screedflo batch on site to the exact requirements, so there is no waste or issues with over or under ordering
- We can supply more than one screed product at the same visit, subject to volume requirements.
- We have a fast-drying screed called Rapide, which at 50mm has been shown to be dry within 14 days of installation.
